

With A Little Help From My Friends: Enabling Communities To Include People With Disabilities

This workshop is about social connections. It has been designed for those who work in generic and disability community organisations, services, people with disabilities and families. The aim of the workshop is to enable marginalised people to not only be present in community life, but also to participate and to develop personal freely given community relationships. The workshop will provide ideas but no recipes, about how to think and work differently. This includes thinking about the roles of people with disabilities and how we all might support these.

Presented by Jane Sherwin, a Queensland based consultant who works alongside agencies, individual and families to transform our communities to be more welcoming places. Her recent work with agencies has included mentoring of teams trying to foster social inclusion; workshops, action learning and mentoring in social connections using two practice frameworks; planning around individuals; and evaluations of projects which focus on the development of freely given relationships.
